General Discussion

The Chairman welcomed the members to the Meeting. Prof. Gnanamoorthy, Director, briefed the members about the functioning of the Institute and also recent events.

The Board members were informed about inauguration and trial operation of the first 50 KWp Roof Top Solar Photo Voltaic power plant installed at Academic complex. The unit will generate solar power approximately 70,000 KWh / year which is fed into the grid and

being utilized for own consumption. This unit is in addition to the existing solar street lamps, solar water heaters in all hostels and super heated steam generation using solar panel in the mega mess in the campus.

The Board was further apprised about approval for setting up "Teaching Learning Centre for Design and Manufacturing Education" by MHRD under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT) scheme. Exchange of students under MoU with Nagaoka University of Technology, Japan, invited lecturers and industrial interaction during the period were also informed.

Visit of Team from Education Consultants India Ltd (Edcil) towards preparation of Detailed Project Report for IIITDM Kancheepuram

For the reasons explained therein the Revised Detailed Project Report (RDPR) for IIITDM Kancheepuram was prepared by the Institute and on approval, of the Board based on the recommendation of BWC, RDPR was forwarded to MHRD for accord of approval (in Jun 2012, Dec 2012 & Nov 2014). The matter was subsequently pursued with the Ministry for an early Approval. For the reasons best known to MHRD, the preparation of RDPR has been entrusted to EdCIL.

The Team from EdCIL visited the campus and interacted with the Institute in order to obtain the inputs required for the preparation of RDPR. They have been explained the action taken by the Institute so far in this regard. They have been apprised of the

academic programs planned as approved by the academic council of the Institute and also intake year wise from the beginning. Even though the DPR 2003 envisages student strength of 1200 (which includes 100 PhD scholars), taking in to consideration of omission of UG program in the DPR the team has been requested to keep the student strength as 1500 and to provide the necessary infrastructures to cater the student strength proposed. The capital and recurring expenditure made from the beginning of the Institute Vis-à-vis the budget Grant-in- aid received from the inception of the Institute has been explained to them as per their request.

It has been further substantiated to them that the various ongoing construction activities are as per the approved yard stick and the specifications adopted in various infrastructures are as per the specification approved by the Ministry of Urban Development and also to suite the GRIHA rating. The MHRD at the start of the project itself has advised the Institute to obtain the GRIHA rating for the Institute permanent campus. Accordingly the campus has been registered with the GRIHA for large area development scheme.

The various site development and other internal external services required for the campus including rain water harvesting, horticulture etc., has been explained with the specific mention about the works completed, in progress and to be taken up.

They have been explained the requirement of various buildings to cater the student strength of 1500 with a built up area of 1,40,000 Sq.M. in total. The building construction activities also explained with the details of already completed, in progress and to be taken up. The Board has already accorded approval to take up this built up area.

As per the academic programs envisaged the number laboratories requirement and the detailed requirement for equipments and furniture both for academic and administrative and hostel has been explained. The library books procurements both in hard copy and digital format, e-journals and software licenses have been explained to them. The master plan and various infrastructure drawings have been explained to

them and shown at site also. They have been interacted for the inadvertent omission of the various infrastructures in the original DPR 2003.

The team has informed that they will work on the report and revert back to the Institute. They have been made a specific request to interact with us before submission of RDPR to MHRD.

The Board noted and expressed that the fund flow from MHRD needs to be increased for smooth progress of ongoing and pending works. The Board has also expressed that the student and corresponding manpower and infrastructure must be planned for a much increased student intake to the tune of ~3000 for better utilization of resources.

Item No.09 | Appointment of Consultant Engineer (Civil) on part-time basis for IIIT Kurnool

The infrastructure development at permanent campus @ IIIT Kurnool is being undertaken for IIIT Kurnool. In order to deal with the matters concerning preparation and evaluation of technical drawings, building estimates and co-ordination with the CPWD, Shri. K. Sundaresan, Retired Superintending Engineer from CPWD has been appointed as Consultant Engineer for a period of one year at a consolidated pay of Rs.42,000/- per month.

The Board noted the appointment of Shri. K. Sundaresan as Consultant Engineer for IIIT Kurnool.

Item No.10 | Status of the Court Case

In the 30th meeting, the Board was informed about Writ Petition No. 17571/2015 filed by Shri. Senaa Kanian Sivaa, Career Development Officer (on contract) against his termination of contract. He has obtained stay from relief till the period of his engagement from the High court of Madras. The Institute has filled counter Affidavit and has engaged Shri. Karthick Rajan, Advocate to vacate the stay and defend the case.

The Board noted the status of the Court Case (WP 17571/2015 filed by Shri. Senaa Kanian Sivaa, Career Development Officer (on contract) in the High court of Madras) and action taken by the Institute.
